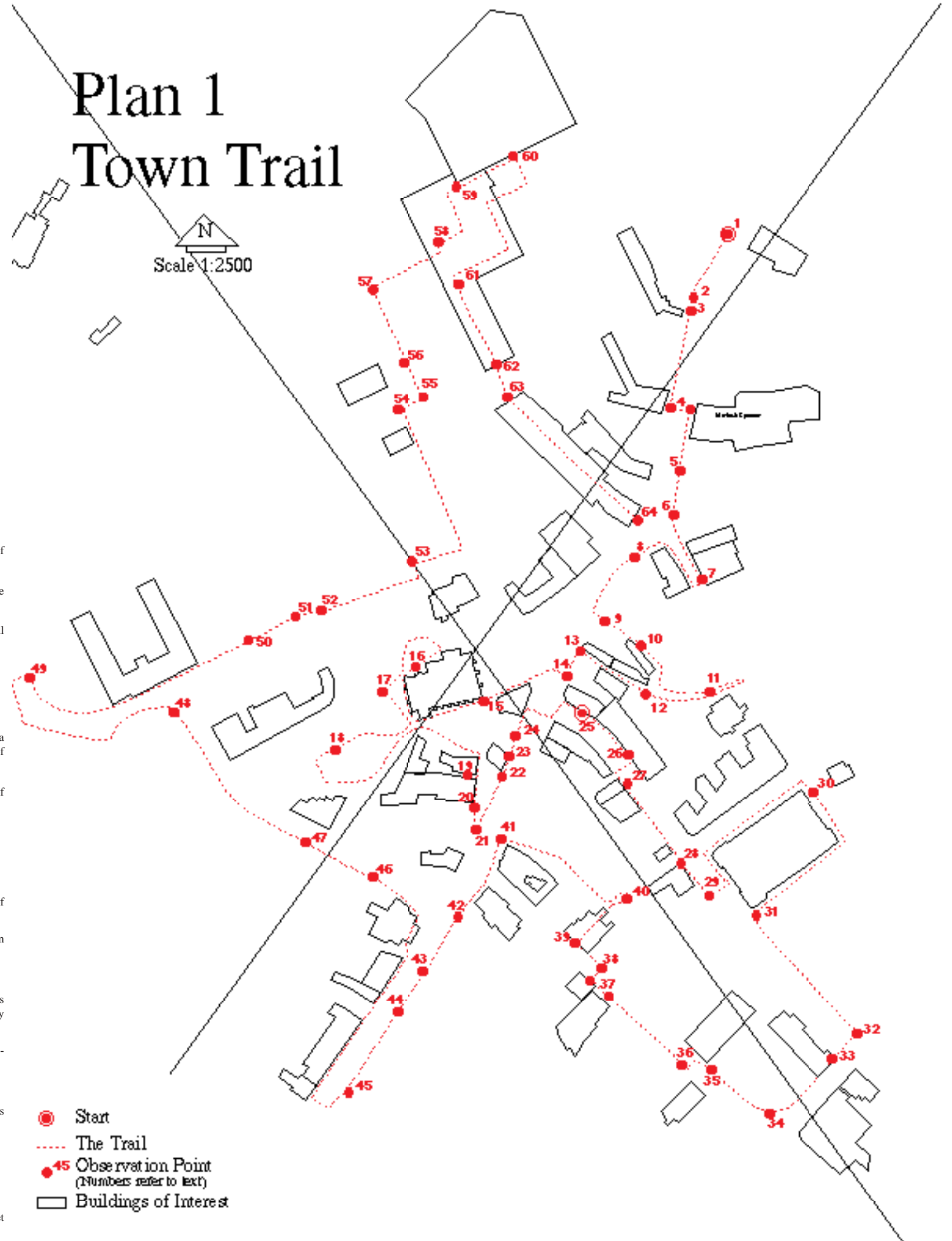




# Plan 1 Town Trail

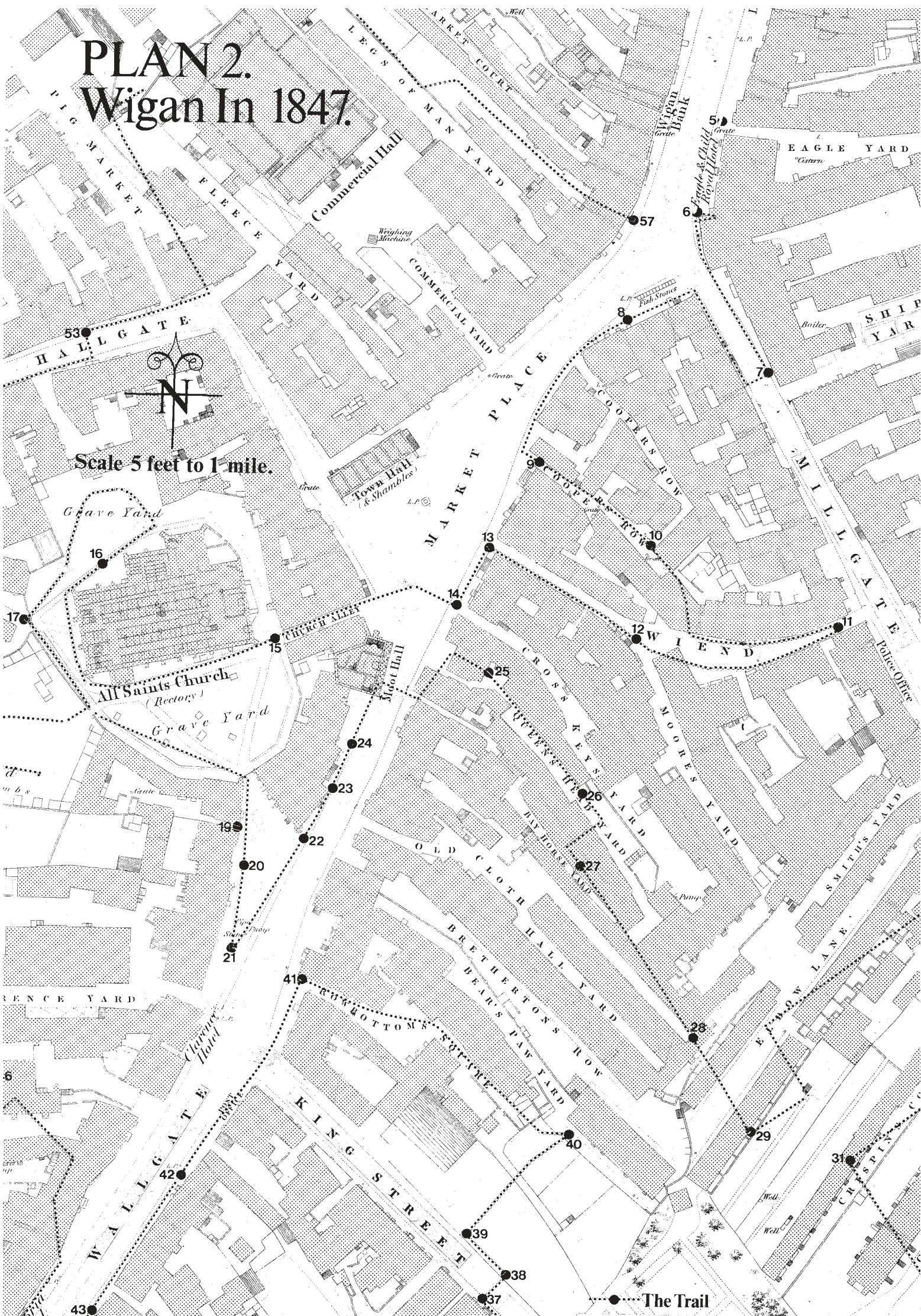
